2. Musical Update

- Amazing turnout and quality of talent within the school
- Having a very hard time narrowing it down there are 12 primary speaking roles and we are still looking for 2 parents to act in the performance
- Had about 11-12 parents who said they would volunteer to help overall
- Callbacks were sent today for lead roles to decide which ones will get the roles
- The performance will be done here at the school with 6 shows 10-11 am / 1-2 pm /
 7-8 pm taking place over Catholic Education Week in May

3. EQAO Party

- Current grade 4 and 7 students who participated in EQAO testing last year will be treated to a celebration party
- This is to celebrate where the school was and where we are now to encourage kids to keep striving for good results
- We have been considered a priority school from the Ministry of Education for the last 6 years because our literacy and math scores being very low. What this means is that the Ministry puts more funding and extra supports into the school.
 - This year, we are no longer an identified priority school at least for grade 3
 - Grade 6 had a big jump from 5% to 26% we are still not at ministry standards but have made a significant jump jump

9. Camp Brebeuf

- Previously we have been going to Mount Mary but as administrators there has been a lot of discussion about the value, length of time, level of supervision, people available, etc. at night for safety and security
- A lot of administrators have started to move towards Camp Brebeuf
- Last year after Mount Mary Mrs. Harris took the initiative to have the school make the decision to try it this year it seems to be more active
- Bingo will allow to offset the cost to families of up to 50% (\$320 approximate total)
- Comparatively Mount Mary was approximately \$275 last year
- Grade 8s will do \$100 off the cost
- We've been doing the same thing for a long time there has been talk about not doing it at all due to the risks involved in the grade 8 retreat but for this year this is what we're going to do

• Not sure it is as spiritual as Mount Mary but will be a good comparison

10. Attendance Campaign

- Have reminded the students, attendance is important for success and they have to be accountable for this themselves – teachers have done different things to track attendance and encourage students to come to school
- Goal is to have 90% attendance by the month
- Last year the monthly gift card was a \$100 gift card for the whole school this will continue
- Each class has a prize bin that the students will run once a month
- Last year CSAC supported the monthly prize
- Attendance has increased the month we ran the campaign so there was a correlation, but we can't indicate causation

11. Fundraising

• ECU Spelling Bee

- No cash will need to be done in cash online
- Children must spell a word to the family member and will have to sign off; will have to come back and do them in front of the class/group
- Work with the teachers at their various levels to get appropriate words

Readathon

- Reading or Math fundraisers \$5 each
- Feedback on the spelling bee is that it is not inclusive kindergartens, special needs students can't participate so it would not be equitable
- Many feel that with not getting something in return, families are less likely to participate, especially in the financial climate we are currently facing
- Can we look at Macmillan's to continue with this as a the big one and do the spelling bee or readathon as a secondary smaller fundraiser
- Stemmlers was extremely popular and successful but doesn't meet the nutritional standards
- After discussion, the goal would be to switch to Stemmlers it its approved to be determined by end of week; if not, proceed with MacMillan's with a goal of having this out and completed before the holidays
